**November Meeting Minutes** — Jan submits motion to approve November meeting minutes, Genet Singh seconds (U).

**Election of Trustee** – We have a vacancy on the board to fill due to finding out after last month's election that Josh Lea resides outside of the defined Clifton boundaries. The three candidates for the board tonight are Steve Goodin, Ben Pantoja, and Mindi Rich. Mary Pat Lienhart collected the ballots.

Steve Goodin has been elected by the board to serve in the open trustee position.

#### Treasurer's Report – Tim Noonan.

The financial reports for the month are complete and sent to the Secretary. One change is that the balances of grants have moved to the liability side and that can be misleading.

The Safe Clifton Fund is now up to \$4k. In addition, we have an additional \$500 left from the Neighborhood Support Program (NSP) grant that we need to allocate tonight. Tim Noonan put forth motion to transfer the remaining \$500 to Clifton Recreation Center, Gerald Checco second, Passed U.

#### Police Report - Officer Shawn Dent, Cincinnati Police Dept. (CPD)

Officer Dent – Officer Dent said that criminals are highly active during the holiday season.

Gerald Checco asked about Charles Brewster who was allowed to stay in a resident's home on Jefferson Ave. and he ended up robbing them. He said he heard that Brewster is utilizing a mental stress defense and asked Officer Dent if he had any update. Officer Dent said that he heard that the renter of that apartment may not have been acting just as a Good Samaritan and may have had a quid pro quo situation with the perpetrator.

Gerald also asked for an update on the incident where a patron of the Hookah bar kidnapped a young man on Ormond Ave. He said a suspect has been arrested, Christopher Smith and he has fourteen charges pending. Officer Dent said he would gather information about this incident.

Tim Noonan asked for a status on Dwayne Taylor. Taylor had a recent incident where he harassed a woman at the ATM on Ludlow and was arrested again. He has been seen many times in the area even though several citizens have a restraining order against him. Officer Dent explained that if he is not committing any current violations, it is unlikely that he will be arrested.

Peggy Moses mentioned a recent incident that occurred on Amazon Ave. There was a man in tree and police were called. District Five came and arrested him and determined that the suspect was a rapist and had outstanding warrants.

## Clifton Recreation Center (CRC) Report — Collin Fitzpatrick

CRC toy drive is currently underway with twenty-three centers participating. There will be a craft night on December 15. CRC is currently conducting a fundraising drive through the end of the year. Eighty percent of donations go directly to the centers and are used for scholarships for the before and after school programs as well as the summer program.

### Clifton Branch Library — Jeanne Strauss-De Groote

Hunger games fan packs are available for free at the library. This Friday at 10:30 is the book club. Plant Club will be on 12/16 and there will be a plant trivia game. Dino Buddies reptile encounter program will be on 12/19.

## Clifton House Tour – Aaron Weiner / Ionna Paraskevopoulos

Aaron Weiner told us that they are going to revive the Clifton House Tour. Historically this tour was held every three years but the last one was cancelled during Covid. The date for the 2024 tour is Mother's Day. Clifton Cultural Arts Center will serve as the fiscal agent for the tour and will manage back-end responsibilities. The target is for this event to net \$20K in proceeds. They are

currently looking for sponsors and have asked for sponsorship of \$500 from CTM as well as assistance in recruiting volunteers (one hundred needed).

Gerald said that the CTM financial sponsorship will have to come as part of the 2024 budget/grant process.

### **Clifton Area Neighborhood School (CANS)**

No report for this month.

**Zoning issue** – This is a change to the agenda. We received notice of a zoning request from Cincinnati State concerning parking garage signage. Due to the timing (the hearing is this Wednesday) we need the full board to review this tonight. Nick Gregg proposed this as a new agenda item, Barry Gee second. Passed U.

Jayme Ritter and Nestor Melnyk announced their resignation from the Housing & Zoning Committee, effective immediately. Nestor Melnyk read the following statement:

"We are resigning from the Housing & Zoning Committee where we serve as cochairs.

It is best practice for boards and commissions to seek out and include in their memberships professionals and subject matter experts to provide guidance to their organizations. It was logical, therefore, that we would co-chair the Housing & Zoning Committee so that Clifton Town Meeting could benefit from our professional experience and expertise as architects knowledgeable on planning and design issues with a particular understanding of codes and processes.

We have been accused of profiting from our roles on the committee, we have been told that our service on the committee is a conflict of interest, and our honesty and integrity has been questioned. Nothing could be further from the truth. Our only vested interests are as residents of Clifton to maintain, promote, and enhance the neighborhood in which we live.

Words are powerful, and we will no longer accept accusations and abuse for volunteering our time, energy, efforts, and professional expertise to the Housing & Zoning Committee."

Cincinnati State issue – after discussion we will not respond since we are out of the timeline. Gerald stated that the new board should investigate our bylaws to determine if CTM can have a process to respond to the issues that require a quick turnaround.

Jan Checco thanked Jayme and Nestor for their serious and dedicated service to the community and said she understands the disappointment that they have felt related to the unfounded accusations.

The Hookah bar remains an issue that we are monitoring.

Our crime rates have stayed the same and are concentrated in a few areas of the community. Car thefts remain high.

Theft crimes are still a major factor in our crime rate. Resolution rate is low so please focus on prevention.

Gerald Checco will be attending court this week to ask the judge to extend Duane Taylor's restraining order for five years. Gerald also stated that CTM has asked the city to update the panhandling ordinance to create a buffer of fifteen to twenty feet from any doorway where you could not panhandle.

#### **Community Questions/Concerns:**

Gerald Checco stated that it has been his pleasure to serve as Board President. He said that the role is unnecessarily tough with all the attacks on social media. He feels this has become a game not unsimilar to the divisiveness going on in national politics.

Mary Pat Lienhart wanted to say a few words given this is her last CTM meeting as a trustee: "What this has boiled down to for me is thanks, and no thanks. This community is very fortunate to have such talented people volunteer, and I stress volunteer, their time and I thank them for that and for the support and friendship they have extended to me over the two years I've been a trustee. This that I particularly had the chance to work with, I really do wish to thank Gerald and Jan for their tireless commitment to Clifton day in and day out, morning, noon, and night. Rachel, I want to thank you for your passion and your perseverance. I do appreciate it. Justin, your enthusiasm is contagious, and you get things done. Thank you very much. Nestor, Jayme, and Nick, I wanted to thank you for your expertise, educating others, and the guidance on the city regulations and our impossible bylaws.

Now unfortunately for the no thanks. When I ran for the board in 2021, I did some thinking that I could help. I've lived in Clifton for twenty years and worked in the community negotiating difficult and contentious agreements. I volunteered at various organizations and served on various boards. But we as trustees don't always agree but we have been able to agree to disagree and move on in a congenial manner. What I was not prepared for was the community response to CTM. Not just the different opinions, but false assumptions, accusations,

conspiracy theories and the name calling. Luckily, I don't do social media. So much of it I learned after the fact. I have been on emails, telephone calls and public meetings where people have done such things. So, for this past year, it is emphasized for me that no good deed goes unpunished, and therefore I chose not to run for another term. In some ways I felt like a quitter. But I thought for my own piece of mind, and preserving my good opinion of the Clifton community, it is best that it is from the sidelines. I will commit to the next board That I will continue to support you, help when asked, and forever be thankful for your willingness to give your time, effort, and skills to the community. Finally, I ask the community, especially those that have served as trustees in the past, to afford the new board some latitude. Things may not be perfect, or perfectly executed, but appreciate those serving are doing that in the best interest of the community and what they believe is good for all of us. Thank you."

Rachel Wells asked for an update on the committee looking into the unhoused issue in Burnet Woods. Gerald Checco stated that we need to give the committee time and space to work out this issue and he is looking forward to seeing some developments over the next year.

Malcolm Montgomery thanked Eric Urbas and Adam Balz for leading the efforts to get the holiday decorations up on Ludlow.
