#### Discussion and Vote on 2022 Meeting Dates -

Gerald Checco presents new dates to improve transition for new board members in the future.

2022 Meeting Dates: January 3, February 7, March 7, April 4, May 2, June 6, July 11, August 1, Sept 12, Oct 3, Nov 7, Dec 5, January 9 2023

Monica Windholtz asked about publishing candidate bios in the Chronicle in line with new election dates. As print deadlines for Chronicle don't work with new election dates, Jan Checco suggests we publish candidate information on the website and social media instead.

Motion to change CTM board elections to November by Robert Hamberg, seconded by Mary Pat Lienhart. Vote (U)

Motion to accept proposed Calendar by Mary Pat Lienhart seconded by Nestor Melnyk. Vote (U)

**Treasurer's Report and Budget Presentation** – Gerald Checco presented a budget plan. CTM has four bank accounts—General Fund, Arts & Culture, Chronicle, and Savings CD. Annual budget is approx. 85k in a normal year, one of the largest in the city. Revenue comes from 6 key sources—Membership, Grants, Arts & Culture, Chronicle, Golf Outing, and CCF Projects. Most of the revenue is used for expenditures. *For additional details, see attached slides.* 

Treasury Challenges are shared. The House Tour was a major source of income but it is unclear if we will have another, or if we should replace it with something to earn similar income. Many events were impacted by the pandemic and need to be revived to improve community engagement. Memberships are an important source of income to maintain.

Carolyn Miller suggests we need stronger membership, Robert Hamberg agrees and points out that it is an important part of the Membership committee and board's work this year. Patrick added that finding information about CTM meetings via the website is challenging. Monica Windholtz plans to address this via her role with the Communications committee.

Motion to temporarily accept proposed 2022 Budget, to be <u>revisited in March meeting</u> by the board, by Robert Hamberg seconded by Mary Pat Leinhart. Vote (U)

Neighborhood Activation Grant – Proposal for CTM,CBA, CCF – Gerald Checco; City of Cincinnati has created a fund to help business districts with capital programs. The deadline is before the next CTM board meeting. CBA is developing two proposals and has asked for CTM's support. (1) One proposal is for safety along Ludlow Ave., installing cameras to prevent graffiti, littering, and other crime. This will help Clifton remain competitive with other districts which currently have cameras. (2) The second proposal is to create more outdoor dining via a plaza at Middleton and Ludlow, including wraps around utility boxes around the neighborhood that are frequently marked with graffiti. Location

If granted, CBA controls the grant money. CTM is only being asked to support the proposal to improve CBA's chances of getting funding. Joyce Rich adds that CBA's projects have been in development for the past 1-1.5 years.

Kevin Marsh shared this <u>link</u> for additional detail. There will be multiple rounds of money available. The first round is the largest opportunity.

Gerald Checco responded to Candice Matthews questions on community input—the proposal was sent to CBA and CTM presidents just 10 days ago.

On proposal 1, Brendon Cull expressed the need for a clear process and plans—who will look at the footage and follow through. Eric Urbas added that deer cameras had similar challenges a few years ago. Gerald shared that these cameras have a different intent to focus on graffiti, so there is less need to continuously monitor them.

On proposal 2, Robert Hamberg asks about the safety of the location, given it is near a bus stop and there are crime and safety issues at the other bus stop near the Shell station. Multiple attendees expressed the need for more details from CBA on these plans and concerns over the fast timing needed to get proposals submitted.

Robert Hamberg suggests CTM develop additional ideas for future NBDSG rounds. Tim points out that future grant rounds offer significantly less funding. Gerald suggests we ask CBA for detailed plans by Jan 15, then decide to have either an emergency meeting or an executive committee meeting to vote on January 18th.

Motion to hold an additional CTM meeting on Jan 18 for discussion for grant applications by Robert Hamberg, seconded by Jan Checco. Vote (U)

**Pedestrian Safety/Traffic Calming Request from City** – Mike Schur; City requested CTM identify 2 locations for traffic calming by January 28. The specific program focuses on high traffic streets (Ludlow Ave., Clifton Ave., Vine St.) where bump outs and speed cushions are appropriate measures.

Candice Matthews points out the need for traffic calming on Clifton Hills and Central Parkway, supporting De Paul Cristo Rey students. The Transportation committee will look at other mechanisms to help in these areas in the future, as these streets do not apply to this program. Robert Hamberg requested speed cushion cost details in order to address Clifton Hills and other parts of the neighborhood through other sources of funding.

Carolyn Millers asks if the bump outs have an impact on turning buses, favoring speed cushions. DOTE traffic engineers will be responsible for the specific, final plans.

Motion to submit traffic committee's recommendation of location 1 and 2 (with 3 & 4 as alternates) by Brendon Cull, second by Mary Pat Lienhart. Vote (U)

Gerald Checco: Proposes CTM start a monthly calendar to help people understand what is going in on our community. It should include times and locations of committee meetings, as well as other key information like board decisions and thank you's to recognize volunteers. All committee chairs should set their meetings soon. Relevant dates and events can be published to the Chronicle as well.





# **Treasury Challenges**

- Chronicle has been stable for the last two years (i.e. Expenses <= Revenues)</li>
- House Tour is a major source of income for General Fund and for Events. Not sure when the next House Tour (or House & Garden Tour) will be.
- Pandemic was believed to be over by mid summer to early Fall 2021. Need to revive events
- Membership is the #1 source of income for Administration and Committee support. Membership
  received three ways, by mail, in person and by PayPal. Should send notice of expiration of membership
  for renewal when memberships expire.
- Off Ludlow Gallery is a high-volume accounting operation.
- Chronicle is a high-volume operation, with lots of follow up needed
- Golf runs semi-independent
- Treasurer needs to check postal mail at least 3x per week, for Chronicle, Membership, but also all Administrative correspondences and notifications (H&Z)

# Request to CTM from DOTE for Pedestrian Safety & Traffic Calming Locations

CTM Transportation Committee
January 3, 2022

# Background

- Request from City of Cincinnati Department of Transportation and Engineering (DOTE) received on October 26, 2021
- Sent to each community council across the city; send two street segments for consideration for traffic calming.
- Traffic calming tools for this program: **bump outs** and/or **speed cushions**.
- Request are to include a short description of rationale of priority of each location.
- All requests received will be scored, and then ranked. Funding will be allocated to the most urgent/at-risk locations first, until all funding has been expended. Due to limited funding, it is unlikely that all locations will receive funding.
- Respond to Melissa McVay at DOTE with top 2 priority locations as soon as possible, but no later than Friday January 28, 2022. Requests received after January 28, 2022 will not be considered.

# Criteria for Locations

- This Traffic Calming program is for streets with more than 5,000 cars a day (i.e., Ludlow Ave, Clifton Ave, Vine St)
- Funding is limited, so this is a competitive program. Each request will be scored on several factors, including:
  - History of pedestrian crashes
  - History of cars leaving the roadway
  - History of fatal or serious injury crashes
  - Proximity to a neighborhood business district
  - Proximity to a school, recreation center, park or other pedestrian generator
  - # of and frequency of bus routes
  - % of zero-car households

# Traffic Calming Tools for Program

## **Speed Cushion**



A speed cushion is like a speed hump, but has wheel cut outs to allow emergency vehicles to pass through unimpeded. Regular-sized cars and trucks however must reduce their speed to the speed limit in order to drive over the speed cushion comfortably. Speed cushions cannot be used on streets with steep grades.

## **Bump Out**



A bump out (or curb extension) extends the sidewalk into the parking lane where 24-hour parking is present. The bump out visually and physically narrows the roadway, which can result in slower driving speeds.



# Clifton Locations Identified and Prioritized

1. Ludlow Ave between Whitfield and Cornell (speed cushions); or at Whitfield (bump outs)	Calm eastbound vehicles on Ludlow entering the business district; prevent vehicles passing on right as lanes merge from 2 to 1 (bump outs)
2. Ludlow Ave at Ormond (speed cushions or bump outs)	Calm traffic in business district; improve pedestrian visibility at crosswalk (bump outs)
3. Clifton Ave between McAlpin/Woolper and Resor (speed cushions)	Calm northbound traffic approaching intersection; calm traffic around schools and mosque. (Note: speed cushions are scheduled for installation on Clifton near Warren.)
4. Vine St between Woolper/Forest and Ehrman	Address high numbers of crashes in area, including recent pedestrian fatality



Subject: NBDSG, grant opportunity

#### **Background**

The City of Cincinnati is introducing the Neighborhood Business District Support Grant Program (NBDSG), which was created in response to the adverse economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. This proposed \$1.9 million program will include funded activities such as capital projects, business start-up expenses, and other investments that will help neighborhood business districts stabilize and recover to build stronger communities through the development of affordable housing. Aid to small businesses may include both direct support to the business, as well as support to enhance outdoor spaces for COVID-19 mitigation (e.g., restaurant patios), or to improve the built environment of the neighborhood (e.g., façade improvements).

DCED has contracted with HOMEBASE (HB) for the purposes of administering the grant program, which will begin in December 2021, with HOMEBASE performing the initial application intake and review.

Applicants must be neighborhood based not-for-profit organizations and priority for funding will be given to Community Councils, Neighborhood Business Associations, and Community Development Corporations.

#### **Deadline**

The first round of applications/awards will be for infrastructure support and the deadline for Round 1 applications is **February 4, 2022**. The range of the infrastructure support grants is between \$50,000 - \$200,000.

The second round of applications/awards for both small business and infrastructure support, will begin February 25, 2022. The small business grants will be \$10,000 or more. There are separate applications based on the assistance type requested.

#### Discussion

These Grant opportunities are clearly for **Infrastructure** type work (as opposed to programmatic needs) in support of the Business District. To that end, I have met with representation of the Clifton Business Association and the Clifton Community Fund. Several meetings are still needed to define scopes and costs, but we are proposing two proposals.

#### **Proposal #1:** Safety along Ludlow Avenue

The purpose of this proposal is to install safety cameras along Ludlow. This project has been a priority for CBA for a couple of years.

Local merchants have been challenged by activities including graffiti, destruction of plant material, excessive littering, and aggression. They believe that security cameras will help contain these issues before they become unmanageable. As citizens return to previous life patterns, one important criterion is a sense of safety

where they recreate. Clifton is competing with other Business district that have cameras and security in place. Scope and cost estimate for the project will be finalized by January 15. Cost is estimated to be in the \$40,000 range.

<u>Proposal #2:</u> Plaza at Middleton & Ludlow/ Wrapping of large utility boxes (4 locations)

The purpose of this proposal is to create a plaza for outdoor dinning at the northeast corner of Middleton and Ludlow, and to wrap with historical photos the large utility boxes along Ludlow at Middleton, Telfdord, Clifton and Brookline. The plaza will serve as an anchor of the business district and compliment the two plaza zones, Digg's Plaza to the East, Clifton Plaza/Telford in the middle and now the proposed Middleton Plaza on the western edge of the business district. It will serve the restaurants on that side, as outdoor dining.

The four large utility boxes along Ludlow are located at Middleton, Telford, Clifton and Brookline continue to attract tagging. Our neighborhood has had a successful program of "Art on Utility boxes" that has deterred graffiti. This new initiative would seek historical pictures of the neighborhood to be reproduced and then wrapped the boxes.

Cost is estimated to be in the \$30,000 range (\$22,000 for the plaza and \$8,000 for the wraps)

#### Recommendation

This effort is clearly for the Business District needs and led by the Business Association. CTM and CCF are partnering with CBA to present stronger proposals. I recommend that CTM approves my participation, as a CTM Trustee, to complete these proposals.
